Care Instructions Peperomia Obtusifolia

The Peperomia Obtusifolia is an easy-care plant that is sure to add texture and shape to your collection. As an evergreen, it is characterised by its glossy cupped leaves and bushy habit. It has



a thin and small root system perfect for any shallow pots you may be wanting to use. It also has succulent-like leaves which retain water. This reduces the amount of watering required.

Native to South America, Peperomia are very easy to grow indoors if they are given enough light and not overwatered. They do well with fluorescent light, making them an excellent plant for spots that don't receive as much natural light.

Light: Likes bright indirect sun light. They are very happy under florescent lighting making it an excellent office plant.

Water: Allow soil to dry out before watering and do not let pot to sit in water. It doesn't like to be overwatered so err on the side of caution when it comes to watering. The rubber-like leaves store water which makes the Peperomia drought resistant.

Maintenance. Ready potted in our Foliage Studio premium potting soil, no need to repot for 12-24 months. Fertilise twice in the summer months with our GT Foliage Focus Plant Food and will not require any further fertiliser for the rest of the year.
